Milton Players Board of Directors Meeting Minutes Wednesday, April 8, 2015

Glenn, Vicki, Jen, Erin, Dawn, Frank, Laura and Pat in attendance.

- I. Minutes from the last meeting were approved.
- II. **Corresponding Secretary Report** – No report.
- III. **Treasurer Report** – Statement for February shows that more money was dispersed than was made.
- IV. **Insurance Update** – Dawn looked into updating the insurance policy, but it was decided to keep the same policy the Players currently had.
- V. **Front of House** – About half of the forty-two positions have yet to be filled for the performances of “The Dixie Swim Club.” Glenn has sent out an email looking for volunteers. As of now, the first Saturday night is covered. Erin will ask for volunteers on the Callboard.

Glenn has started to update the list of duties to be split between Maureen and Bruce beginning next season.

VI. **Business Manager Report** – Ticket sales are going well except for the Sunday performance. Saturday night is almost sold out with just a few tables left.

There are currently 115 season subscription holders. Subscriptions for next season will be available for purchase at the box office of “The Dixie Swim Club” performances.

VII. **“The Dixie Swim Club” Production Report** – Set will be completed this weekend. The last few chairs, table and sofa have been found. Dawn will contact Milton Yacht Club and ask if the Players can borrow some decorations for the set for the last scene change.

Costuming is done except for one costume.

A lighting technician might be needed for the performance on 4/19 if L.A cannot do it. Possibly Dawn or Kenny.

Program production is going slowly. Some bios still need to be submitted.

Dawn will check Vista Print for t-shirts for set crew. Pat will look into local moving companies for t-shirts.

The day before opening night is the time when the tables and chairs will be set up. A theme for the tables will be shells.

VIII. **Member-at-Large Report** – Nothing to report.

IX. **Publicity Report** – Signs about “The Dixie Swim Club” are up around town. Pat has contacted the *Suburban Shopper* about placing an ad in the 4/22 issue. Articles will appear in the *Suburbanite* and the *Milton Times*. The editor for the *Milton Times* may be able to see the show the first weekend and print a review. Pat will get pictures out to the rest of the local papers.

Erin contacted Sarah about the headshots and Sarah will bring them on Sunday. Dawn will make the board for the lobby. The headshots will be 8x10.

The LED sign in front of MHS is already advertising the show.

X. **“Addams Family” Production Report** – The production staff had their first meeting last week.

The Players have decided to order all of the production materials and the advance pack to keep.

It was decided unanimously that five orchestra instrumentalists will be paid \$75 per show. The pit will be on the floor stage right.

Audition dates are 6/22, 23, 24. Information regarding auditions is already posted online.

For a choreographer, it was motioned to hire Phyllis DeLaricheliere. (8 votes yes). It

was also decided by 8 votes yes to have Maureen as Stage Manager.

Dawn will reach out to Milton High School for Pugsley and Wednesday auditioners. Dawn will ask Steve about an audition poster to email out to local schools.

There is a possibility of adding four tables to the house for “Addams Family.” Dawn will look into options regarding buying tables and renting chairs.

A producer, and possibly an assistant producer, is still needed. Erin will post on the Callboard for co-producers.

XI. **MHS Report** – Frank met with Brian to give him the check from “Caught in the Net” sales.

XII. **2015-2016 Ads** – Kevin would like to have a campaign for ads for next year. Discussion was tabled until further notice.

XIII. **Play Reading Schedule** – Glenn handed out a proposed schedule. The Committee will be approved at the next Board meeting. Suggestions include new Board members for next year.

Next year's Board members will be invited to the May Board meeting by Erin.

XIV. **Milton Non-Profits Group** – Frank is going to the event on 5/13 and will report back on it.
