## The State of Milton Players

*Paid memberships and donations grow, but we still have a long way to go...*

As of September 6, 2004 we had 43 paid members. Donations ranging from \$10 to an anonymous donation of \$500 had been received, totaling almost \$1300. As appreciated and wonderful as this seems, it only helps a small amount.

Treasurer Mary Quatomoni reported at the September 6<sup>th</sup> board meeting that after paying off current bills and the remaining debt from last year that there remains only about \$2000 in the bank.

Our first show, “Annie” has an estimated budget of approximately \$11,000 dollars. This includes, royalties, rental fees for the scripts and libretto, set, costumes and the rental of the Women’s Club.

Sounds sort of scary, doesn’t it. How are we going to cover expenses?

The good news is that all of our past debt is paid off and we currently do not have outstanding debt. When the budget for “ANNIE” was set, we looked at the numbers of people attending Musicals over the last few years and expect to make a few thousand dollars if
